Preparing for your Professional Property Photography

If you live in a flat or apartment then you have less control on the overall look of the exterior. If you have a balcony or garden we advise you to make this into a positive usable space, add some plants and a dining table and chairs so the viewer can see how usable the space is, outside space is an important feature for flats and apartments.



3. Kitchens & Bathrooms

It tends to be these rooms which naturally gather the most clutter that we keep around us every day but it's important to get kitchens and bathrooms looking perfect for your photo shoot.

All bottles, cleaning products and food products should be removed from the kitchen worktops, leave your appliances as well as any plants or decorative accessories.



With bathrooms the best approach is to have it as clear as possible.

A viewer will want to see the bathroom suite alone, so anything else is a distraction.

Move any cleaning products, bottles, toothbrushes, bath mats, shower caps and any other accessories you may have.

Leave hand towels and any towels folded neatly on your towel rail.
